

## **GENERAL INFORMATION, RULES & SUGGESTIONS:**

1. **STUDENTS ARE NEVER TO BE ALONE!** All student **MUST** be with at least one other person at all times. Anyone in violation of this rule will be assigned to an adult to travel with for the remainder of the trip - **NO EXCEPTIONS!**
2. Be wary of strangers...this is not the time to make **NEW** friends outside of Band.
3. **DRESS CODE:**

\*For safety reasons, at the parks, all students & chaperones will wear sponsor donated color coordinated shirts

Day 1 - Red Shirt

Day 2 - 2019 Show Shirt - Parade Day!

Day 3 - Green Shirt

Day 4 - Yellow Shirt

\*All clothing must be school appropriate outdoor wear:

\***SHORTS** - shorts must be as long or longer than your knuckles when your arms are held straight down by your side. Loose fitting clothing is highly suggested.

\***SHIRTS** - the donated shirts should not be altered.

\***SHOES** - comfortable tennis shoes with socks are highly recommended! We will do a lot of walking & it is no fun to get blisters.

*And now....A message from Disney:*

*Proper attire, including shoes & shirts, must be worn at all times. The parks are a casual, family-oriented environment & Ensuring that the parks are family friendly is an important part of the Disney experience.*

*Attire that is not appropriate for the parks - which may result in refusal of admittance:*

*\*Masks may not be worn by Guests 14 years of age or older (unless they are for medical purposes)*

*\*Clothing with objectionable material, including obscene language or graphics*

*\*Clothing which, by nature, exposes excessive portions of the skin that may be viewed as inappropriate for a family environment.*

*\*Clothing with multiple layers are subject to search upon entry*

*\*Objectionable tattoos.*

4. Do not leave money or valuable in the hotel room or in the bus cabin. Chaperones **will not** hold money for you. There will be a container underneath each bus that will be locked up while we are in the parks. Items such as iPads, laptops, bags & other valuables may be stored there. **DO NOT** place cash in these containers. You will not have access to this bus while we are **IN** the parks.

5. Mr. Findley & Mr. Mayo need to be notified in writing of all medicines that your student will be taking during the trip. **The medical release form** (it's attached) **must be turned in to Mr. Findley by Tuesday, March 31<sup>st</sup>**. Please be sure to include medication name, dose & time to be taken...this includes all over the counter medications. If you take Motrin, Tylenol, anti-acids regularly - they must be listed. The Band staff will carry student's medication throughout the trip & administer when needed. Students must carry their inhalers; EPI pens & diabetic testing supplies due to immediate needs. \*\* It is not mandatory but HIGHLY encouraged for all Chaperones to also fill out a medical form to have on file, in case of an emergency.
6. **No alcohol, tobacco, drugs, VAPING, etc.** as per school rules AND Disney's rules. Disney's policy has changed & doesn't allow ANY type of smoking or vaping inside the park. If anyone is caught vaping, Disney will ask them to leave the park & they will then answer to our school administrator, Dr. Norton. Remember, this is a school sanctioned trip & we are representing Brighton High School.
7. Cell phones are allowed & encouraged because the students will be given information regarding a free App from Bob Rogers Travel where information can be shared securely, pictures can be uploaded which will later be made into a memorial DVD, etc. Students are also HIGHLY encouraged to have an external battery charger, to keep the cell phone charged throughout the long days at the parks. 8. Games, books, PG video & DVDs are welcome. All musical devices must have earphones. Electronic devices are permitted but are the responsibility of the student. All pictures, videos, cell phones, iPod's & cameras must contain school appropriate material.
9. When buying souvenirs, please do not buy weapons (swords, knives) or liquor glasses/shirts, etc....this is a school trip.
10. Everyone is expected to be respectful to students, adults, teachers, bus drivers, other travelers & tour guides at all times.
11. Should any problems arise, please let Mr. Findley, Mr. Mayo or Mrs. McKenzie know immediately. We can't help if we aren't aware of the situation.
12. Everyone attending this trip as a student, administrator & chaperone will follow the same itinerary. For security reasons, we cannot have different groups or individuals altering the schedules or rules in any way. **NO PARK HOPPING!**
13. Per TCBOE policy, all luggage will be checked by faculty and/or chaperones before it is allowed on the bus.

#### **WHILE ON THE BUSES:**

1. A small blanket & pillow are great items to have on the bus but **CANNOT BE SHARED**
2. Snacks & a small (six pack size) coolers are permitted on the bus but must stay in your area & can't be stowed in the aisle. Please remember this bus is our "home" for the entire journey, so we need to keep it clean. Make sure coolers don't leak, pick up your trash, etc. Please use bottles with replaceable tops rather than cans to help prevent spilling.
3. We will spend the 1<sup>st</sup> night on the bus then have a full day at WDW Magic Kingdom before checking into the hotel. Please keep a change of clothing, all toiletry items (i.e. toothbrush, deodorant, etc.) **NO AEROSOL PRODUCTS PLEASE**, and spending money for the 1<sup>st</sup> day with you on the bus. We will **NOT** be opening the locked luggage compartments under the bus when we arrive at Magic Kingdom.
4. You may have 1 suitcase under the bus - no larger than 28", with wheels is helpful since the student will be carrying their own luggage to their rooms.

5. There will be no mixed gender or dating couples allowed to sit together on the bus.
6. Bus attire...wear comfortable/appropriate clothes. No **pajamas or onesies please**. We will be stopping along the route to change into fresh clothing Wednesday morning. Remember, we are representing BHS at all times.
7. Please confirm that your medication is with your bus captain for the overnight portions of the trip.

#### **AT THE PARKS:**

1. You are representing Brighton High School so please conduct yourself in a respectful manner at all times.
2. Please wear a watch or have a fully charged cell phone each day so you will be aware of the time & when to check in with your chaperones. Again, an external battery charger is **HIGHLY** encouraged for your cell phone.
3. It is **HIGHLY** encouraged for each student to have their own cell phone (for safety reasons) but if you do not, **YOU MUST** travel with someone who does so that you can be reached by a chaperone.
4. You must adhere to the schedule of meeting & check in times. If you fail to be in the right place at the right time, you will be assigned to walk with a chaperone for the remainder of the trip.
5. Florida's weather can be unpredictable. It is advisable to bring a lightweight jacket & a poncho(s). They are very expensive in the parks.
6. Selfie sticks are **NOT** allowed in the park. They will be confiscated at the gate.
7. Please **NO** flip flops in the park. They will break & shoes at Disney are very expensive.
8. Please **DO NOT** cut lines or "save" someone a space in line. Disney frowns upon this!

**Let's make sure our parade performance is the most memorable impression we make at Disney!!**

#### **FOOD:**

1. You will be responsible for food on the bus trip to & from Disney.
2. We will be stopping at The Mall at Barnes Crossing in Tupelo, Mississippi. Dining choices:
  - a. American Deli, Charleys Philly Steaks, Chick-fil-a, Pretzel Twister, Tropik Sun Fruit & Nut, Yolo Rollo
3. We will eat breakfast at the hotel each morning (not the 1<sup>st</sup> full day) & everyone attending will receive one food voucher for each day. The food vouchers include: an entrée, a side, drink & desert. The portions are big, so an idea might be to pair up with a friend & think about splitting a meal for lunch & then for dinner. That way your stomach will not be too full when riding the rides. Anything above (more than) that is your responsibility.

### **IN THE HOTEL:**

1. In the hotel, students will stay together in rooms of four. Parents do not stay in rooms with students & vice versa.
2. Please remember we are not the only guests at the hotel. Be respectful to the other guests. Private security guards will be monitoring the hallways each night.
3. Please be respectful to your roommates - wear pajamas!
4. You are not to open your door for anyone except a BHS chaperone or Director/administrator.
5. NO running in the halls, yelling or banging on wall/doors.
6. You should not be out of your room wearing pajamas. Please be properly dressed.
7. When we ask you to be in your rooms, you are to stay in your rooms. We will have security guards, assigned to our students, in our hall. If you open your door & security calls Mr. Findley, expect to be sleeping on a chaperone's floor.
8. AT NO TIME will boys be allowed to go into a girl's room or vice versa!
9. ABSOLUTELY NO FaceTime **OR any other** camera/image communication while in the hotel.

- 10. No one is allowed to change rooms; the rooming list has been completed & submitted. If your trip is not paid in full by 3/27, Bob Rogers will not give you a room.
- 11. Chaperones will check rooms at bedtime for a roll call. Students will receive a “good morning” phone call each morning. 30 minutes later, chaperones will conduct a face to face “good morning,” making sure that EACH student is up & moving.

**\*\*We can’t emphasize this enough. Please remember that you are on a SCHOOL trip. All BHS & TCBOE rules apply. Should any serious infraction of these rules occur, the student will be sent home immediately by either air or bus, whichever the parent prefers. All expenses will be the responsibility of the parent. This has never been an issue on any of our trips before, so we want to do everything in our power to make sure it does not occur now.**

**WHAT TO PACK & GENERAL SUGGESTIONS:**

- We will be doing A LOT of walking!!! Wear comfortable shoes! I can’t stress this enough. There’s nothing worse than your feet hurting the whole trip. It is also a good idea to bring a 2<sup>nd</sup> pair of shoes, in case 1 pair gets very wet, they can dry out.
- Florida weather can be unpredictable. Check the weather channel the week before we leave but also pack a rain poncho. The cheap ones are fine & may be even better so the students can throw them away after, but then pack several.
- SUNSCREEN, SUNSCREEN, SUNSCREEN!
- Hat
- Sunglasses
- Fanny pack
- External battery pack for cell phone & cell phone charger
- 1<sup>st</sup> day of clothes (Shirt, Shorts, underwear, socks, deodorant, baby wipes to freshen up, toothbrush & toothpaste in a small drawstring bag (the red Brighton drawstring is perfect) for the bus.
- Snacks, for the bus & crackers or protein bars (something easily mobile) for the parks, between meals.
- A few ziplock sandwich bags to keep phones dry in rain or water rides.
- **\*\*\*Download the app MY Disney Experience - Walt Disney World and set up your account. Through this app, you will find maps of WDW, wait times for rides in real time, dining information & YOU will set up your OWN Fast passes once we get the ticket information from BRT. Since we are staying offsite, the fast passes can be set up at 30 days out.**
- We are setting up a Facebook page to be able to disseminate information & give tips right up until we leave. This page will be for the students & adults going on the trip AND for the Parents/guardians of the students.
